Heraldry in An Tir continues to thrive. This quarter's reports are generally upbeat and happy, though I am distressed to note the number of reports that were not received. I will be stressing how very critical it is that reports be sent in. In three cases this cycle important questions reached me via a quarterly report that I would have otherwise been unaware of. I am worried that other things aren't reaching me because those branches aren't reporting or attempting to contact me with problems.

I have one major open position in the college, Queue Forchée Herald, my contingency deputy. The announcement of the opening went out in the December Crier. Frederic Badger (Couronne Rouge Herald) continues as my acting contingency deputy until the new Queue Forchée Herald is selected.

The college is down to one tabard. I have retired the two that were made with the Kingdom's Arms quartered with the badge of the College of Heralds. Since the Kingdom sets the standard and pattern for branch tabards I felt it necessary for us to Set A Good Example by removing these tabards from public view. They

imply things about the relationship between the Kingdom and the College that are best left unexplored. Lady Ellen Frasser has agreed to coordinate a project to build replacement tabards starting after her elevation to the peerage at Twelfth Night. Baron David of Moffat (Electrum Herald) and Gwenlian Catharne (Sinister Gauntlet) are almost done with a lighter weight tabard that should be available soon.
